The aim is to give an intermediate-advanced knowledge of the theory and policy of economic growth and development in a comparative perspective.

Note: in the 2008-9 academic year "Comparative economic development" and "politica dello sviluppo" will at 90 % coincide (same class). In the following years there will be only "comparative economic development".

The lectures will be, at least partially, given in English if foreign students will be attending the class.

Main trends in the world economy and in Europe.  
- Growth and development policies: Italy, Europe, US and the main emerging and developing countries.
