Final dissertation (Tesi/diplomatiki ergasia)

After completion of programme of international mobility, the student is required to write a final dissertation (in Italian "tesi" and in Greek " $\delta i\pi \lambda \omega \mu \alpha \tau i\kappa \dot{\eta}$ $\epsilon \rho \gamma \alpha \sigma i\alpha$ » or "diplomatiki ergasia" under the supervision of a member of the academic staff of one of the two participating universities.

The dissertation will be discussed through an oral examination in one of the two Institutions. The dissertation will be written in English and discussed either in English or in Italian..

Grading system

The Aristotle University of Thessaloniki shall grade the students in accordance with the rules in Greece (from 1-10, 6 being the lowest passing grade) including half grades. The grading for the Diploma Supplement will follow the grading agreed upon by the university in its relations with other universities.

The Università degli Studi di Torino shall grade the students in a scale from 18 to 30.
